Starting a New Chapter Steps to Lau

Eligibility Requirements

To start a DPGI Chapter, you must:

- ✓ Be a passionate and active member of the diamond painting community.
- ✓ Be committed to upholding DPGI's mission and values.
- ✓ Have at least 3 founding members to help establish the chapter.
- ✓ Be willing to organize events and engage with local diamond painters.



Steps to Launch Your Chapter

- Submit an Application Fill out the DPGI New Chapter Interest Form and submit it for approval.
- 2. Meet with DPGI Leadership
 - A short virtual meeting will be scheduled to discuss expectations and answer questions.
- Recruit Members Start spreading the word and inviting local diamond painters to join your chapter.
- 4. Plan Your First Event Organize an informal meetup, virtual gathering, or introductory workshop.
- 5. Get Officially Recognized Once you have an active membership base, your chapter will be listed on the DPGI website, provided an official logo, Chapter Charter, and social media platforms.

Chapter Leadership Roles & Responsibilities

Each chapter should have a leadership team to ensure smooth operations. The basic suggested leadership roles include:

Chapter

President

- Oversees all chapter activities.
- Ensures alignment with DPGI's mission and policies.
- Serves as the main point of contact with DPGI leadership.

Vice President

- Assists the President in planning events and managing chapter operations.
- Supports community engagement and outreach.

Secretary/ Treasurer

(May be dual position welcomes new or separate)

- Manages finances, fundraising efforts, engagement and and budget tracking
- Ensures transparency in financial matters
- Records minutes of meetings.

Membership Coordinator

- Recruits and members
- Manages member communication **Event Coordinator**
- Plans and executes chapter events, workshops, and meetups.
- Coordinates event logistics and schedules.

This format of Chapter Leadership is just a basic idea. Depending on Chapter membership size, activeness of members, additional positions may be put in place to support the chapter and its activities.

All Chapter Officers will be required to participate in DPGI Chapter Officer Training to include Chapter Financial Training.

Membership & Community Engagement

Who can Join?

Membership is open to anyone interested in diamond painting, from beginners to experts. DPGI welcomes members of all backgrounds and skill levels.

How to Grow Your Chapter

- Promote on social media and local community boards.
- Collaborate with craft stores and online groups.
- Organize fun and interactive activities & events.
- Engage members through regular communication.

Hosting Events & Activities

Hosting Events & Activities Events are a key part of any DPGI Chapter. Some event ideas include:

Diamond Painting Meetups – Casual gatherings for members to paint together.

듣 Technique Workshops – Sessions on multiplacing, sealing, framing, etc.

🕇 Supply Swaps – Members exchange unused supplies.

Virtual Hangouts Online sessions for members who can't meet in person.

Community Challenges – Themed diamond painting competitions.

Sample Chapter **Meeting Agenda**

Welcome & Introductions (15 minutes)

- Greet members and newcomers
- Quick round of introductions (Name, favorite diamond painting project, fun fact) ' Brief overview of today's
- agenda

2. Chapter Updates & Announcements (15 minutes)

- Upcoming events & workshops.
- Community outreach or charity project updates.
- Member spotlights & achievements.
- Any chapter business or leadership updates.

3. Guest Speaker or Skill-**Building Session** (Optional - 20-30 minutes)

- [If applicable: Invite a speaker, demo a new technique, discuss framing/sealing tips, etc.].
- Q&A session.

4. Diamond Painting Work Session & Social Time (60-90 minutes)

- Time to Paint! Bring your WIPs (Works in Progress) and enjoy a relaxed session of diamond painting together.
- Play soft background music or an audiobook (optional).
- Encourage members to share tips, techniques, and ask for advice.
- Provide a small table for supply swaps or giveaways (if applicable).

5. Show & Tell (15 minutes)

- Members share progress or completed works.
- Celebrate accomplishments and creativity.

Wrap-Up & Next Steps (10 minutes)

- Review upcoming events and reminders.
- Ask for feedback & suggestions for future meetings.
- Thank everyone for attending.

7. Optional: Social Time & Cleanup.

Allow extra time for members to chat, exchange tips, or pack up their materials.

- ✓ Provide starter kits to help new participants engage in the activity.
- ✓ Encourage members to donate completed projects for fundraising or community beautification efforts.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Q: Do I need experience to start a chapter?

A: No! Anyone passionate about diamond painting can start a chapter.

Q: How many events do we need to host?

A: We encourage **at least minimum** one meeting or event **every two months**, but chapters can be as active as they like.

Q: Can we collaborate with other crafting groups? A: Absolutely! Collaboration strengthens community engagement.

Q: Is there a minimum number of members required? A: Chapters should aim for at least 5-10 active members to start, but there is no strict requirement.
